

Pins for points.....

This program is to promote participation and travel. Rainbow is a great opportunity to expand your knowledge of Oregon and other jurisdictions. Even visiting an assembly across town exposes you to some different traditions and it is a wonderful way to build friendships with other Rainbow Girls.

You will need to keep track of the points on your own. Your Mother Advisor, Board member or parent can check your points. *Score card* is provided below. Pins will be presented at Official Visits by the State Rainbow Dad and State Mother Advisor.

A pin “costs” 5 points. There will be an entire series of special handmade pins. Each 5 points earns you a new and different pin. See how many you can collect this year!

No points are given for attending a function that would qualify for service points.

No points are given for attending a function of your own assembly.

One point events

Every Rainbow girl in good standing gets one “free” point toward their first pin.

Attending a Rainbow function at another assembly.

Bringing a prospective member to a Rainbow/Masonic function.

Attending an adult Masonic/OES/Amaranth/Nile/Shrine function as a Rainbow Girl.

Attending a DeMolay or Jobs Daughter function as a Rainbow Girl. Chapter Sweetheart events or Jobs Daughter events where you are a member do not count.

Attending an Official Visit that isn’t for your district.

Attending a special Rainbow function, i.e. Statewide Initiation, Rainbow University, GWAAR, GWAAR, etc.

Two point events

Attending a function of another Rainbow jurisdiction .

Serving as a pro-tem officer at another assembly’s initiation.

Serving as an installing officer at another Rainbow Assembly.

Bringing an approved candidate to a Statewide Initiation.
